

Personal, Social and Emotional Development




Our focus this term will be around identifying and understanding basic feelings. We will be continuing to encourage using good manners such as 'please' and 'thank you' as well as sharing and kindness.

Communication and Language



This half term our role-play area will be a Vet's Surgery. We will be dressing up as doctors and nurses and looking after the sick animals while using lots of language and discussion. We will be continuing to play a variety of games involving identifying the beginning sound of words to support children with learning their letters and sounds as well as prepositions such as in, on, under, over, around etc.

Literacy



Our focus books this term will be: The Pancake That Ran Away, Tacky the Penguin, The Little Red Hen And The Ear Of Wheat and Rosie's Walk. We will be acting them all out and retelling them with mini-figures to enhance our story telling language.

Mathematics



In Maths this term we will be continuing to learn about a different number each week. Children will be expected to count out a given number (between 6 and 10) and learn the numerals 6 to 10. We will still be recapping 2D shapes by cutting out a different one each week. Our focus on dice games will continue with the games getting a little trickier each week.

Understanding the World

We will be learning about St David's Day (Wales), Holi, St Patrick's Day (Ireland), Mother's Day, Nowruz, Ramadan and Easter. We will also be learning about the Weather and what all the different types are called.

Cooking

We will be making: sandwiches, playdough, toast, fruit salad and Easter Nests.

Expressive Arts and Design



We will be learning new songs that link to our topics and book focus such as the Weather Song, Chick Chick Chicken, the Penguin Song and more songs involving numbers. Physical Education

We will be continuing to practise holding pencils correctly and forming the letters of our name more clearly. Using scissors correctly is still a focus this half term. We will be having fun with assault courses for the remainder of the term.



How parents can support at home:

Reading: Ensure you read to your child every day. Their reading books and Reading Record must be brought to school every day in their book bag.

Mathematics: Count objects with your child and ask them to get you a specific amount.

Begin learning numerals 6 – 10. Play some simple dice games at home.

Make sure your child brings their water bottle every day and ensure that it has their name on it.
