

Personal, Social and Emotional Development



Our topics this term will cover identifying feelings and what they are called. We will use the story 'The Colour Monster' to help with this. We will also be learning about keeping clean and healthy.

Communication and Language



This half term our role-play area will be a Fire Station and Fire Engine. We will be dressing up firefighters and finding out about what they do. We have arranged for some firefighters to come and visit us in June (as long as they don't have an emergency to go to). We will get to see inside the fire engine and squirt the hose. Communication will continue to be fostered in friendship groups and small group activities with adults as well as through story telling.

Literacy



Our focus books this term will be: The Bad Tempered Ladybird, The Hungry Caterpillar, Time To Get Out and The Rainbow Fish. We will be acting them all out and retelling them with mini-figures to enhance our story telling language.

Mathematics



This half term we will be focussing on matching amounts to numerals and ordering numerals. We will continue to play the occasional dice game this half term as well as a range of simple addition and subtraction activities. We will also be learning a little about 3D shapes and their properties.

Understanding the World

We will be learning about Father's Day and Eid ul Adha, as well as Firefighters, Minibeasts, Animals and Sea Life.

Cooking

We will be making: playdough, strawberry ice lollies for Sports Day and potato salad with the potatoes we have been growing.

Expressive Arts and Design



We will be learning new songs that link to our topics and book focus such Firefighter, Down in the Jungle, Tiny Caterpillar, 5 Little Fishies. We will be doing a range of crafts related to the festivals and topics this term, such as, making a fire fighter collage, a clay minibeast, a CD fish, butterfly printing and a lion mask.

Physical Education

We will be continuing to practise holding pencils correctly and forming the letters of our name more clearly. Using scissors correctly is still a focus this half term. We will be going on our trip to the park on Tuesday 18th June to practise our climbing skills there. Do come and join us for out Sports day on Thursday 11th July.



How parents can support at home:

Reading: Ensure you read to your child every day. Their reading books and Reading Record must be brought to school every day in their book bag.

Play 'I Spy' and begin identifying letters and their sounds.

Mathematics: Children can have a go at ordering the numerals they can recognise and practise matching amounts to numerals.

Important Information:

Bring sun hats and water bottles every day.
