

Personal, Social and Emotional Development



We will be learning that others have different beliefs and identifying how to keep clean and healthy.

Communication and Language



We will continue learning a wide range of nursery songs. We will be practising following instructions and using language to communicate with others. We will also be learning lines and songs for our Christmas Show in December. All parents are invited to come and see it. A date will be chosen soon.

Literacy



We will be reading a wide variety of books this term including Night Monkey, Day Monkey and The Billy Goats Gruff. We will be continuing to focus on name writing.

Mathematics



We will be learning the shapes oval, crescent, semi-circle, heart, and hexagon. We will be practising saying numbers in order to 10 and making sure that when we count objects we say one number for each object. Our focus amount for most of the term will be 3 – this is linked to the stories Owl Babies, The Three Little Pigs and The Three Bears.

Understanding the World

We will be learning about Bonfire Night, Remembrance Sunday and St Andrew’s Day. Towards the end of term we will be celebrating Christmas.

Cooking

We will be making: playdough, a smoothie, strawberry milk, and blueberries with cream cheese on crackers.

Expressive Arts and Design



We will be continuing to learn about colours and colour mixing and will be painting and printing with the colours we make. Our colours this half term are: grey, orange, pink, white, blue, silver and gold.

Physical Education



We will be continuing to remind the children to use ‘pinchy fingers’ when holding a pencil. We will be using a wide range of gross motor skills outside: using the large blocks to build, the rainbow streamers, hula hoops, balls, bean bags, tennis bats etc. We will be reminding children to use their feet on the pedals of the tricycles.

How parents can support at home:

Reading: Ensure you read to your child every day. Their reading books and Reading Record must be brought to school every day in their book bag.

Mathematics: Count objects with your child and ask them to get you a specific amount.

Make sure your child brings their water bottle everyday and ensure that it has their name on it. Please write your child’s name in their coat.

Important Information:

Please read the weekly nursery letter so that you know what your child is doing everyday. Please value the work that children bring home and find somewhere you can display it (maybe on the fridge?).
