Year 5 Artists

This term in Art, Year 5 have been exploring installation art. They looked at a range of installation artworks and discussed what installation art is, grouping images together and explaining their choices. The children enjoyed sharing their opinions, describing how the artworks made them feel and justifying their ideas by referring to what they could see. They explored how artists use space, materials and arrangement to create a particular atmosphere or message. The children began to plan their own installations using recycled cardboard boxes and

a variety of everyday and recycled materials. During this process, they experimented with materials, tested different layouts and made changes to their designs as they worked.

Throughout the unit, pupils talked enthusiastically about their designs, explaining the message or atmosphere they wanted to create and imagining how their installation could appear as a full-sized space. They reflected on their creative choices and showed curiosity and growing confidence in discussing and developing their ideas.





Learning in Year 1

Year 1 have been busy embracing the Christmas spirit, enjoying an exciting interactive pantomime and practising enthusiastically for the winter concert. Despite the festive fun, our learning has continued to flourish. We've been ordering numbers to 20, redesigning the school field, crafting stable pen pots, and even taking care of a dragon! 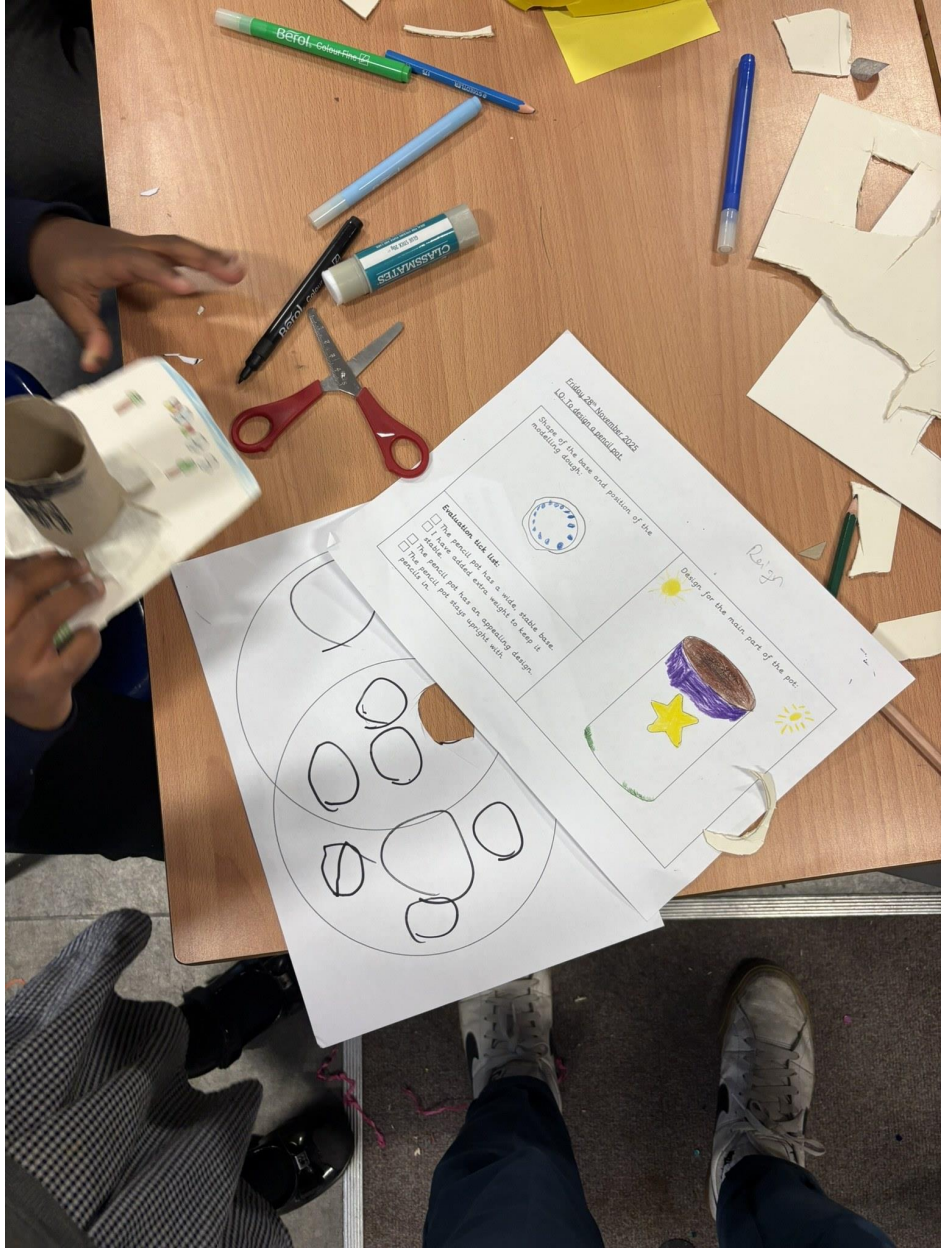

Throughout the term, Year 1 have shown fantastic enthusiasm, creativity, and dedication. We are incredibly proud of everything they've achieved!





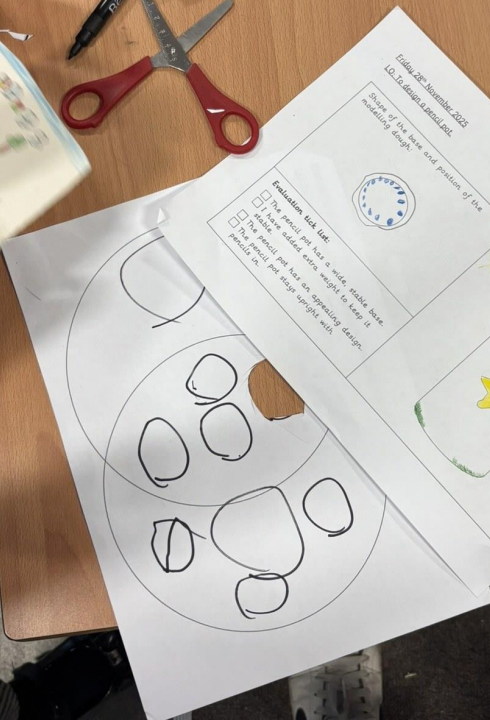
