Our children visited the Natural History Museum, where they learned about evolution and took part in an exciting workshop. They also flew to a nearby island to observe how lizards have adapted to their environment. While exploring the museum, the children saw real fossils of dinosaurs, birds, and mammals, as well as an impressive life-size model of a blue whale, the largest animal ever to have lived on Earth. They also visited the volcanoes and earthquakes section and participated in an interactive activity that simulated what it feels like to be in an earthquake.

A big thank you to all the parents and carers who volunteered their time to support the trip!

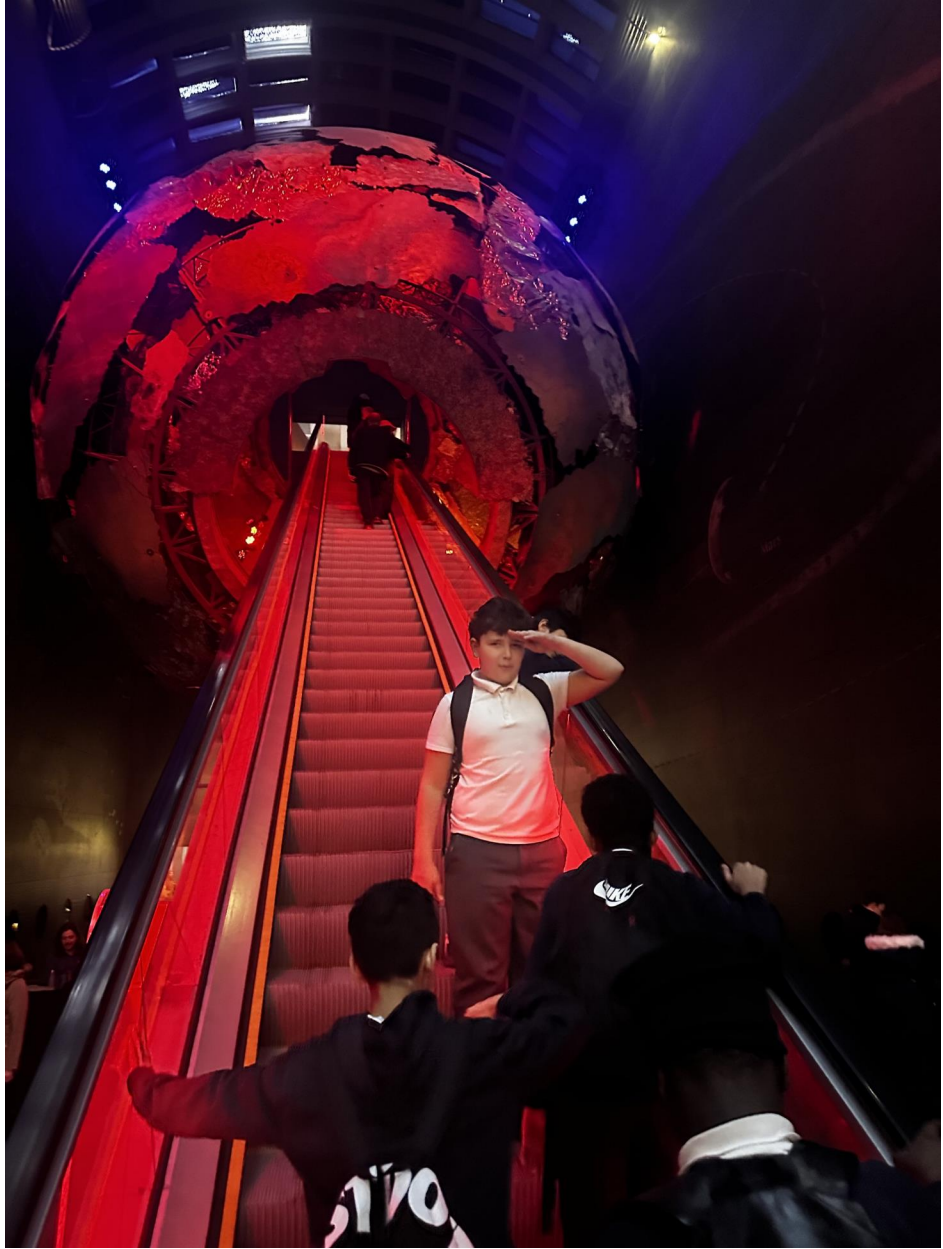






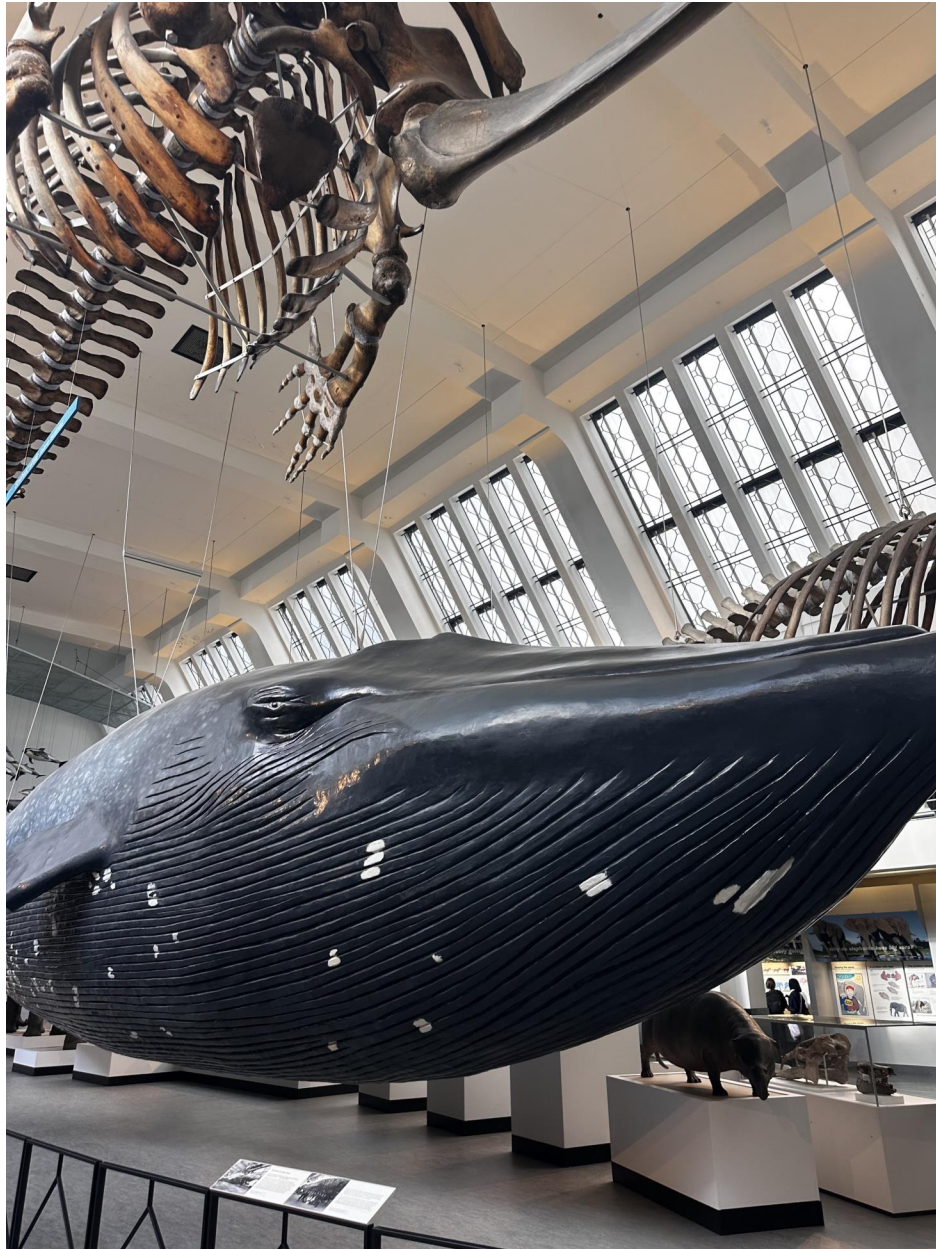












## Wellington Boots for All Weather Fun!

## Operation Encompass

This is to inform you that our School is working in collaboration with the Metropolitan Police Service as part of their legal commitments under Operation Encompass.

Operation Encompass is the notification to schools that a child (under 18) has been exposed to, or involved in, any domestic incident. This includes incidents where the child/young person was not present but is part of the household. This will ordinarily be done by the start of the next school day.

Operation Encompass will ensure that a specially trained member of the school staff, known as a Designated Safeguarding Lead (DSL), is informed. The DSL can then use the information that has been shared, in confidence, to ensure the wellbeing of the child.

The school may be able to make provisions or adjustments to assist the child and their family.

We are keen to offer the best support possible to all our pupils and we believe this will be extremely beneficial for all those involved.
