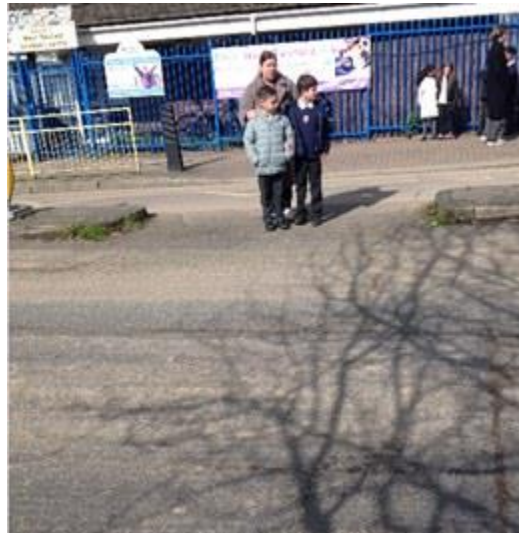
crossing. This helped children judge incoming traffic and distance. They identified with a partner when it is safe to cross.
