## Children's Behaviour Outside School

I have received a number of emails from the local public and concerned parents regarding poor behaviour by West Twyford children outside school.

We have clear behaviour expectations in school and these are in our three school rules: ready, respectful and safe.

I am saddened and surprised to hear reports of poor behaviour from some of our pupils in the local area, especially in the local parks and knocking on neighbours' doors and then running away (sometimes called ding, dong, ditch). I have spoken to the whole school about this and I ask that parents/ carers please support with this. Any poor behaviour reflects badly on the school and makes the local area less pleasant and safe for everyone. I am surprised by this as in previous years I have only had good reports of our children, for example on trips.

Please do remind children them of behaviour expectations, especially if they are attending local areas on their own or with friends.

If you experience anti-social behaviour outside school, this is something difficult for school to deal with. Anti-social behaviour can be reported to the Police on 101 or via the form on the Met police website.
