Learning in Reception

This week in Reception, we read the story '*Somebody Swallowed Stanley*' and discussed why plastic is harmful to sea animals and the importance of looking after our oceans. As part of our sea animals topic, the children were fascinated by sea animals trapped in ice. They used their scientific thinking and problem-solving skills to investigate different ways to make the ice melt. Some children even decided to leave the ice outside in the sunshine to see what would happen!

The children also enjoyed using watercolours to create beautiful sea animal paintings. They explored a range of natural resources, including pebbles and shells, to recreate sea creatures

such as a crab, octopus and jellyfish. During continuous provision, the children demonstrated their growing confidence in writing by independently composing simple sentences. In Maths, the children practised building and writing number sentences linked to number bonds to 10 including composition of numbers, developing their understanding of how different numbers can be combined to make a number.

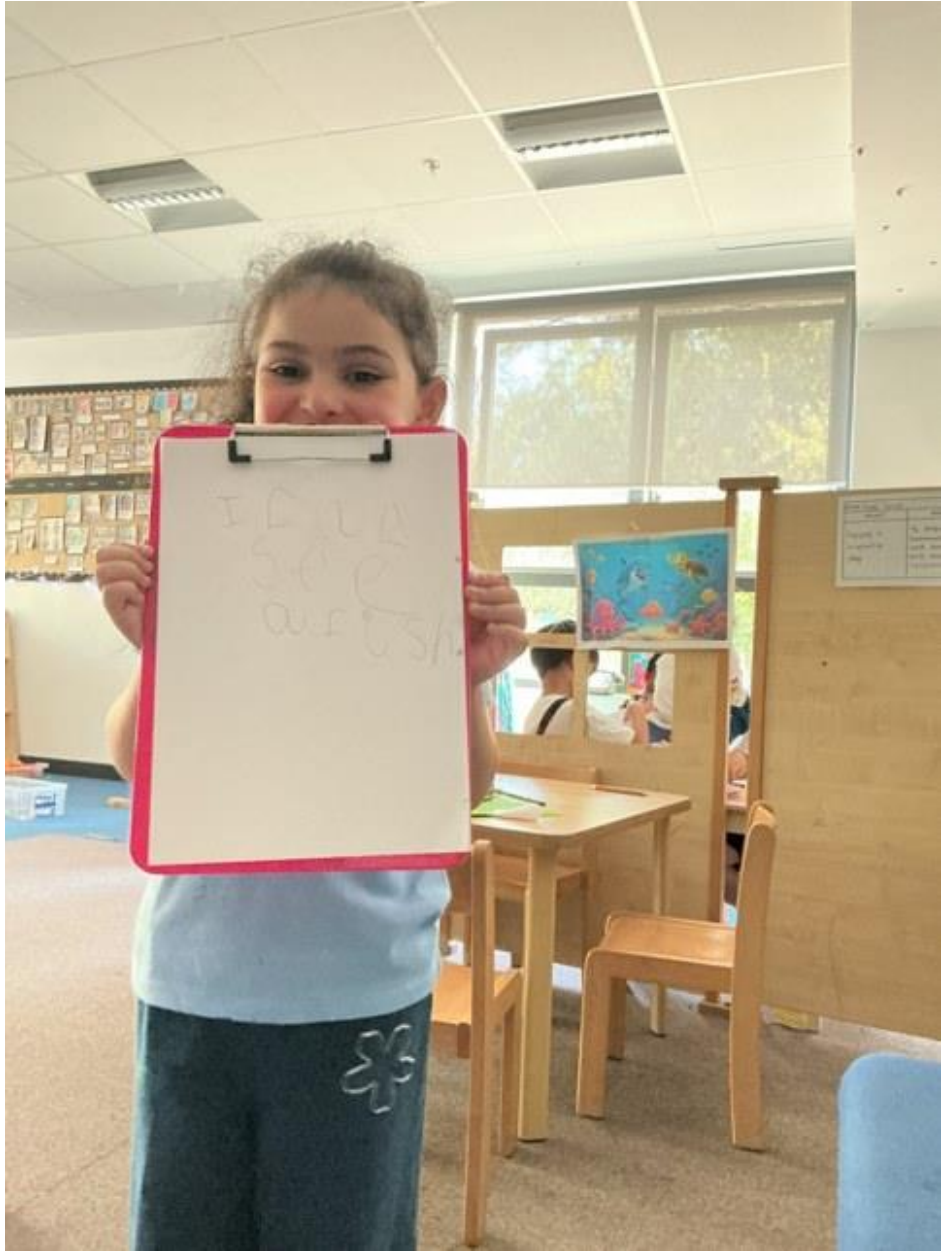
It has been a wonderful week of learning, with the children showing great curiosity, creativity and enthusiasm throughout all of our activities.
