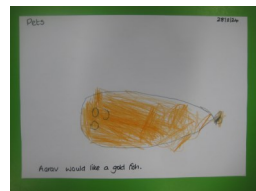

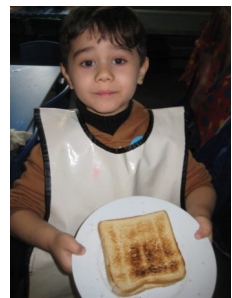


Great Learning in Nursery
